(Aquatic Vegetation Treatment)

The Plan:

Lake Athens 2018 Aquatic Vegetation Management Plan

(Pre-Approved by AMWA & TPWD)

Mechanical and Chemical Treatments are OK with Permit

Treatments 6' down from 440' and 75' out from 440' are generally pre-approved

Most exceptions are expected to be approved as well

Chemical treatments must be applied by licensed applicator

3 Chemical Treatment Windows

May 7 thru May 18 June 11 thru June 22 August 13 thru August 24

Turn in Permits to AMWA Between March 1 and May 31

(May Treatment Window Permit Deadline is April 23!)

Permits Must Be Submitted by Individual Property Owners

Permit Fees are \$34


